

Duo Jetté: Technical Requirements

- An indoor venue with live, resonant acoustics
- Two sturdy, armless chairs
- Back lighting sufficient for reading musical scores, or group can use stand lights.
- Sufficient performance area for bowing, roughly 6' square per performer.
- Sound enhancement will be unnecessary in a live hall, but if it is needed, or if a recording is being made: For close miking: Two vocal microphones at 'F' hole level, or two ambient microphones positioned above.
- Musicians will provide their own music stands, and gamba stands.
- Instruments will need to acclimate to the space for two hours prior to performance.
- A cold environment will cause a lack of stability in tuning. Suggested temperature: 68 to 75 degrees Fahrenheit.

Musicians will be seated facing both each other and the audience, with chairs angled towards center stage. Chairs should be placed downstage center.
